## What is WVRx?

West Virginia Rx is:

- A free prescription drug program\* for uninsured West Virginians
- A charitable mail order pharmacy providing free brand name medications for chronic disease
- A health care resource clearinghouse

*\*West Virginia Rx does not fill prescriptions for generic medications*

*\*West Virginia Rx handles no controlled drugs*

# Am I eligible?

You are eligible for WVRx if:

- You live in West Virginia
- Your yearly income is 200% or less of the Federal Poverty Level
- You do not receive government assistance such as Medicaid, Medicare Part D, or Veteran's Benefits
- You don't have prescription drug coverage
- You can provide a photo ID

## How do I enroll?

**STEP ONE:** For enrollment forms
